## **Instructions:**

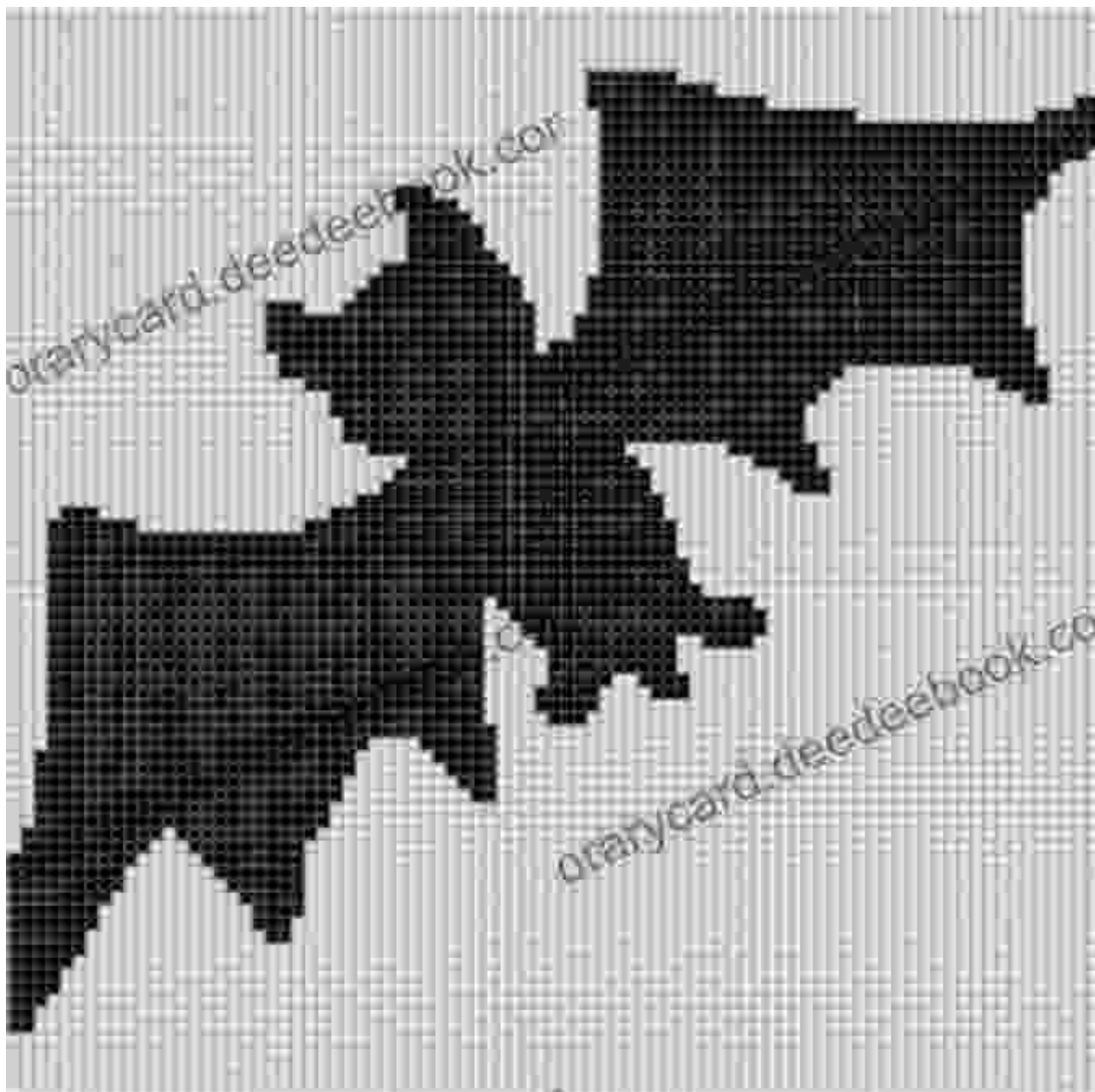
1. Start by stitching the outline of the bat in black floss. Use a backstitch for the outline.

3. Stitch the bat's eyes and mouth in orange floss. Use a backstitch for the eyes and a satin stitch for the mouth.
4. Stitch the bat's wings in purple floss. Use a backstitch for the wings.
5. Frame the finished product (optional).

- Use a sharp needle to avoid snagging the fabric.

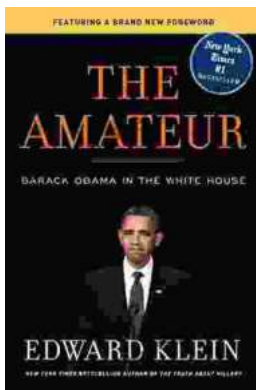
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
