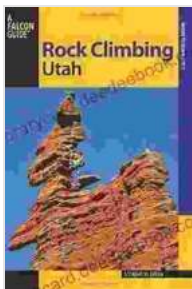


Rock Climbing Utah: 2nd State Rock Climbing Series

- Event 4: Zion National Park - September 23rd

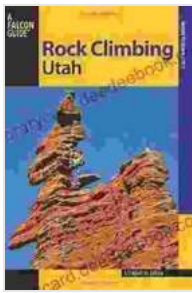
Rules

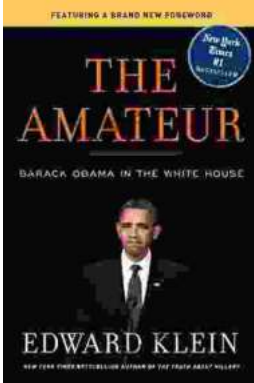

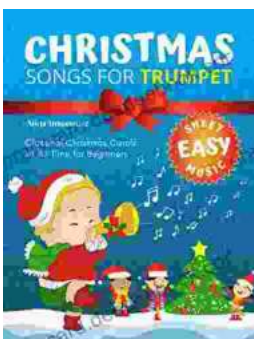
