Selecting the right fabric for your project is important.

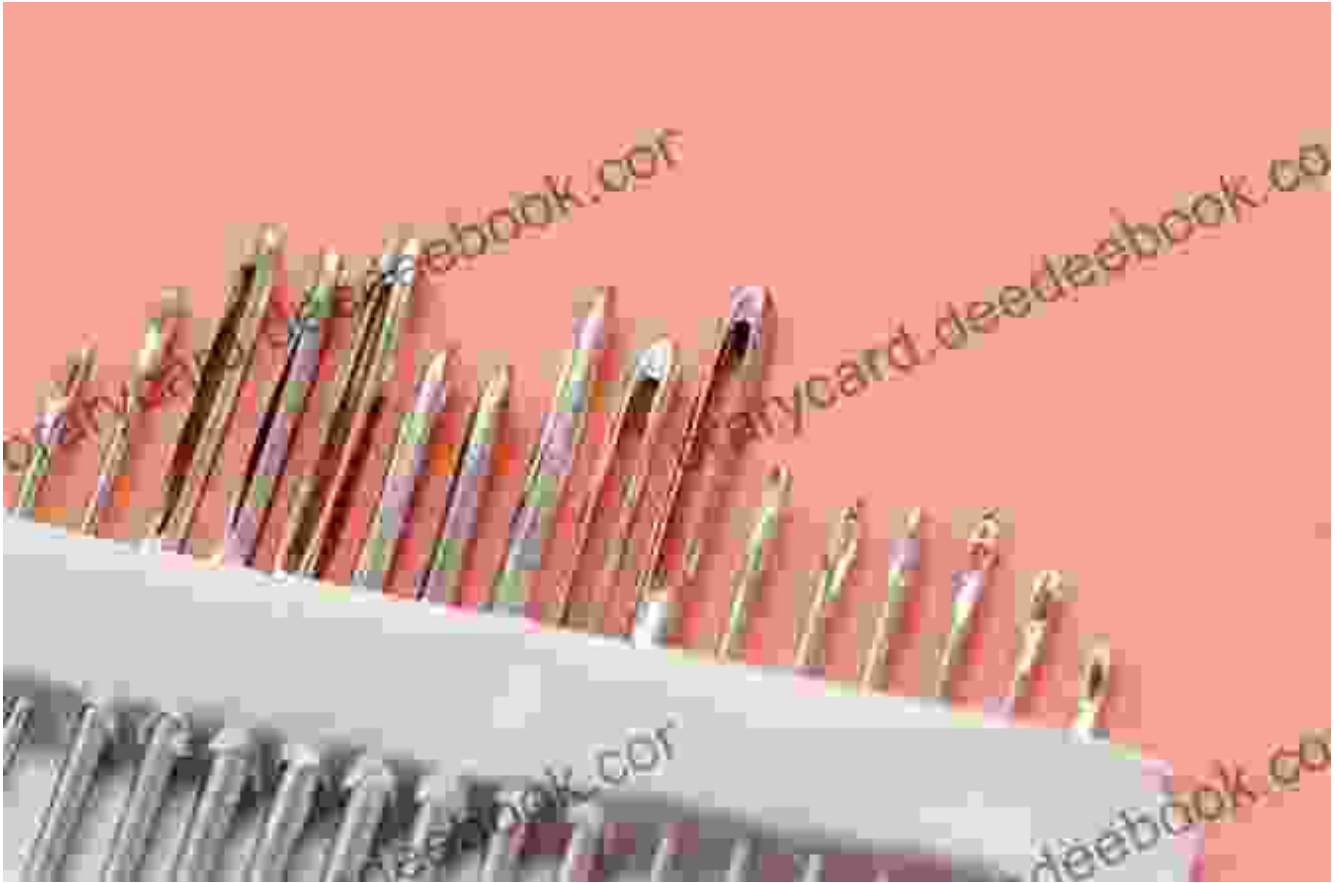
The type of fabric you choose depends on the project you're working on. For beginners, cotton or cotton blends are a good choice as they are easy to sew and handle.

## **Basic Sewing Techniques**

4. Insert the thread into the needle.

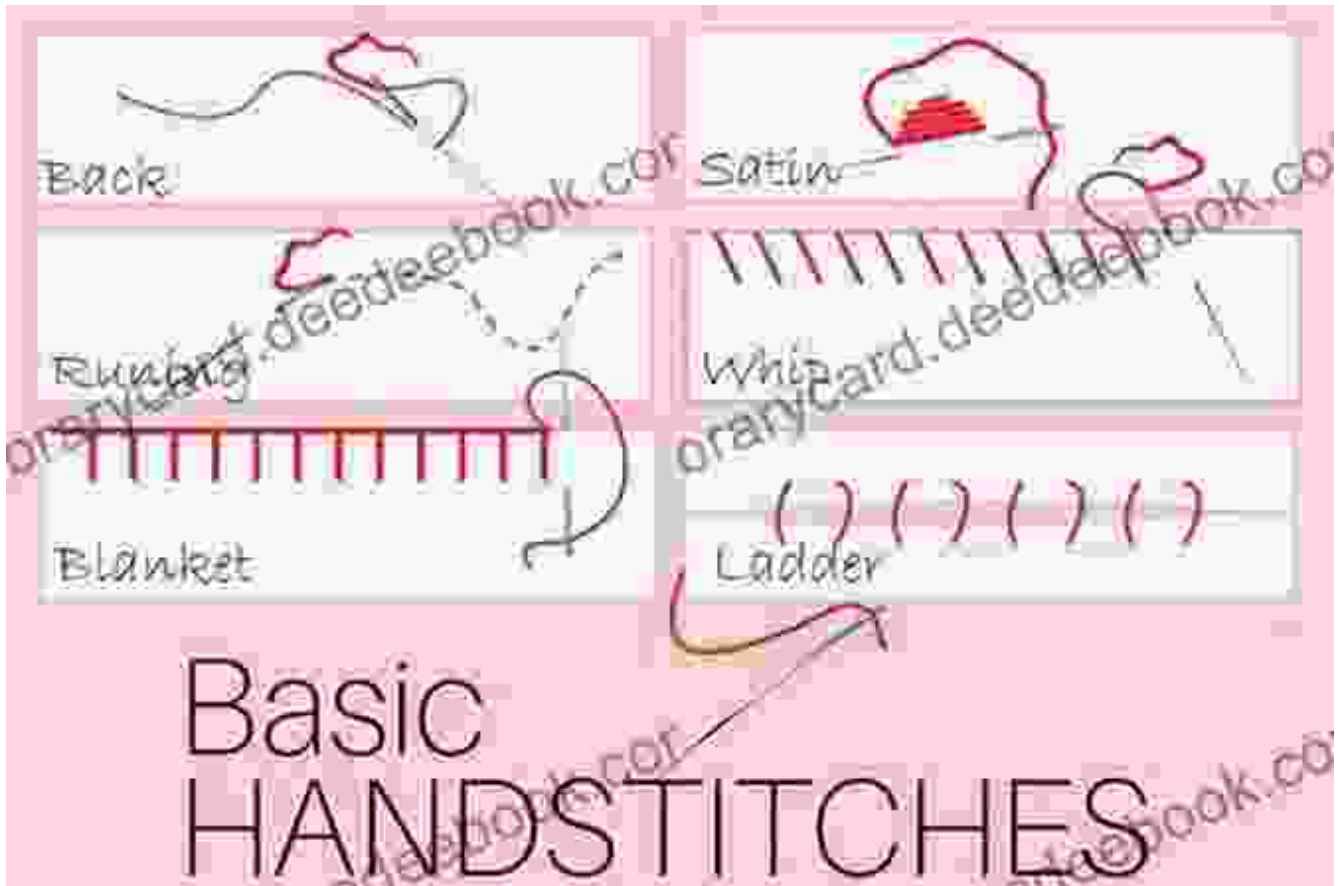
## **2. Winding the Bobbin**

1. Place the empty bobbin on the bobbin winder.
2. Pull the thread from the spool and insert it into the hole on the bobbin.
3. Press the start button and wind the thread onto the bobbin.

## **3. Inserting the Bobbin**

1. Open the bobbin case.
2. Place the bobbin in the case.
3. Pull the thread from the bobbin and insert it into the slot.
4. Close the bobbin case.

## **4. Basic Stitches**



Mastering basic stitches is essential for sewing.

### **Straight Stitch:**

1. Set the stitch length to 2.5 mm.
2. Sew a straight line by guiding the fabric under the presser foot.

### **Zigzag Stitch:**

1. Set the stitch width to 3 mm.
2. Sew a zigzag stitch by guiding the fabric under the presser foot.

### **Buttonhole Stitch:**



1. Select the buttonhole stitch setting.
2. Place the buttonhole foot over the button.
3. Sew the buttonhole by following the machine's instructions.

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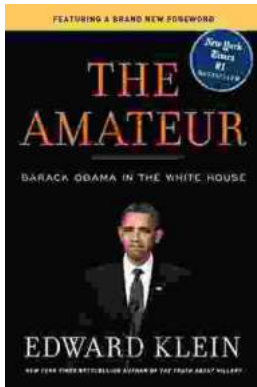
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
