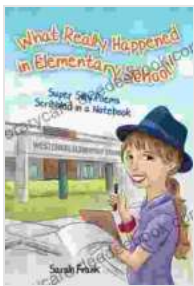

And join the silly poetry jamboree.

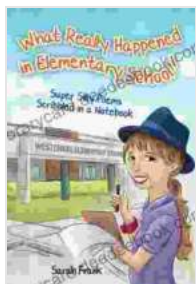

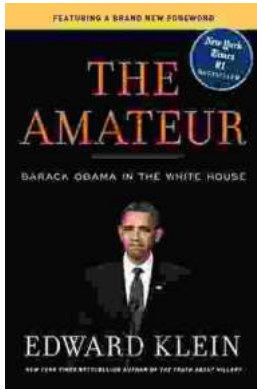
